Grooming: An experienced groom offers classes in the specialised preparation of iberian horses.

### PROSPECTS

Throughout their training pupils are in contact with professionals in all equine disciplines and from all backgrounds. For example, Miguel Bohorquez, world champion in the breeding of P.R.E. (thoroughbred) spanish horses, who has collaborated with Sebastian to train his horses during several years and Luis Valenca who entrusts Sebastian with his horses used in dressage displays.

Therefore students benefit from excellent contacts for finding work in Europe ( according to their level of competence and degree of motivation).

### COURSE FEE

900 Euros per month.

Finca El Alamo has high quality installations including: an outdoor schooling arena, 70m x 30m, an indoor schooling arena, two lungeing corrals, stable block with 20 loose boxes, an outdoor area in which to work horses and a bull-ring.

Courses are given by:

- **Sebastian Zambrano**, a renowned rejoneador who triumphed in the most important bull rings in Spain until his retirement only a few years ago. Many highly respected professionals in the equestrian world entrust their horses to Sebastian's care ( D. Alvaro Domecq, founder of the Royal Andalusian Riding School, Luis Valenca of Portugal, patron of the Bartabas Equestrian Academy).
- **Lucie Brossette**, highly qualified instructress who has worked in many countries including Belgium and the United States, ... She is trilingual: French, English, Spanish

Each pupil will have at their disposal two or three horses (according to the capability of the student):

- a youngster
- a trained horse (doma vaquera and/or high-school dressage according to the student's choice of discipline)

Pupils will therefore benefit from a course adapted to their level and their objectives (preparation to pass international exams, for competition, for entry into an academy such as the Academy of Equestrian Art of Versailles...)
